- Software updates are distributed to an application server at EPL for immediate impact on the customer, making enhancements more frequent and easier to implement.

CUE-Passport is browser-based with a thin client architectural base. The reliable, scalable and secure product is based on the Java 2 Platform Enterprise Edition architecture residing on a SUN Microsystems platform, Oracle database.
